Mercier Touch-Up Kit Instructions



How to use the Mercier Touch-up kit The Touch-Up Marker and Fill-Stick Wax Pen may be used separately or

together depending on the nature of the repair.



Use it to fill nicks, gouges, and scratches.

Touch-Up Marker:

Helps conceal scratches or other imperfections where no filling is necessary. The touch-up marker may also be applied after the fill-stick wax pen application to help blend the color of the repair.



- 1. Clean the damaged surface.
- 2. Make sure you have the Touch-up kit compatible with the species and color of your floor.
- **3.** Fill the imperfection by rubbing the Fill-Stick Wax Pen back and forth.



- **4.** Remove the excess wax with a plastic scraper or a clean cloth.
- **5.** Wipe the surface with a dry cloth.



6. Apply the Touch-Up Marker in the direction of the scratch or defect. Follow the same procedure if using the marker over the area touched up with the Fill-Stick Wax Pen.

7. Wipe off excess marker after each stroke with a clean, dry cloth. Apply marker to the scratch again to achieve a darker color if needed.

This step consists of removing the excess around the repaired area since it becomes difficult to remove it when it dries.

- **8.** Let dry for 30 minutes.
- **9.** Avoid using cleaning products on the repaired area for 24 hours.
