

## **Element Flooring**

## Product description and technical information

The Element tone is obtained from a phenomenon of natural oxidation of the wood which accentuates with time depending on the level of relative humidity in the air and the degree of exposure to light. The intensity and uniformity of the oxidation vary considerably from one board to another. The color of the product will be stronger with time.

Hard Maple Element and Terrain and Hickory Element show a marked color change.
