

Element Flooring

Product description and technical information

The Element tone is obtained from a phenomenon of natural oxidation of the wood which accentuates with time depending on the level of relative humidity in the air and the degree of exposure to light. The intensity and uniformity of the oxidation vary considerably from one board to another. The color of the product will be stronger with time.

White Oak Element and Orage, as well as Walnut Element, have a low maturation and a color change less marked. Hard Maple Element and Terrain and Hickory Element show a more marked color change.

Reaction to light	Fast and intense: Hard Maple Element, Hard Maple Terrain and Hickory Element Light and slow: White Oak Element, White Oak Orage and American Walnut Element
