## **Mercier Moldings**

Designed to meet all you decoration needs, Mercier moldings are available in a multitude of species, stains and glosses to perfectly match your decor.

Molding dimensions measurements are listed in nominal values and may include a tolerance of plus or minus the value indicated in this document. It is important to fit the molding to the adjacent floor. It is common practice to have to remove the tongue from the floorboards in order to properly fit a nosing or a reducer.

## T-Moldings

T-Moldings are the best option for a smooth transition between floors in adjoining rooms. They are ideal in doorways and between two different floor coverings of near identical heights.

## Quarter Rounds

Placed between cabinetwork and hardwood flooring, quarter round moldings create a sense of continuity. They are also great to use as a subtle transition between hardwood floors and wall bases.



### Thresholds

Threshold moldings are used in doorways and at the meeting point of floor coverings (nailed and glued) that are at different levels.

Suitable for:

- Solid
- Engineered 1/2"
- Engineered 3/4"




## Reducers

Reducer moldings are made to create a subtle connection between two floors of slightly different levels. They are ideal to connect wood flooring to vinyl covering or to short-haired carpet. Depending on your specific needs, they can be installed in a flush, overlapped or bi-manner.



## Stair nosings


Stair nosings provide a distinguished appearance to the steps of your hardwood stairway. They reduce damages caused by frequent circulation, hence preserving the beauty of your stairs. They can be installed in a flush, overlapped or bi-level manner. Mercier stair nosings are offered in two versions; the conventional rounded nosing and the square nosing for a modern design, both available in a 92" length\*.

#### Square stair nosings








#### Round stair nosigns


